As part of the International Year of Chemistry 2011 and in partnership with the Swiss Chemical Society, Syngenta is organizing on its campus in Stein, Switzerland a one-day symposium entitled " SCS-Syngenta IYC 2011 Symposium: Modern Catalysis for Sustainable Chemistry ".
